

**COMMUNIQUE ON THE TRANSFORMATION FROM COMMERCIAL
MOTOR BIKE RIDERS ASSOCIATION INTO COMMERCIAL MOTOR BIKE
RIDERS UNION IN SIERRA LEONE**

We, the national delegates from all the regions of Sierra Leone in a national delegates conference at the Saint Edwards Pre-School Hall in Freetown, Western Area from the 19th to 21st of September 2010.

Recalling that the Commercial Motor Bike Riders Association is a post conflict phenomenon;

Mindful of the role of Commercial Bike Riders in the transport sector;

Desirous to see the reduction of poverty through youth employment;

Aware of the tenuous relationship between transport stakeholders, the general public and the Commercial Motor Bike Riders;

Concerned about the potential conflict that arises under these conditions;

Acknowledging the President's call for attitudinal and behavioural change;

Recognizing Commercial Bike Riders aspiration for self reliance;

We hereby declare

- The acceptance of the Commercial Motor Bike Riders Union constitution as amended by this assembly
- To faithfully abide by the dictates of the constitution
- To formally register the union which shall be called the Sierra Leone Commercial Motorbike Riders Union (SALCOMBRU)
- That the election of our national executive body will take place within one year from the date of this communiqué.
- The implementation of a transitional process from association to union should last for a period of one year.

We call on:

1. The National Electoral Commission (NEC), to assist with technical support in the realization of our district, regional and national elections
2. Labour Congress, Sierra Leone Roads Transport Authority (SLRTA), other stakeholders and Civil Society, to assist us in the realization of our goal
3. The Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports, the Ministry of Social Welfare, Gender and Children's Affairs the Ministry of Transport and Aviation and all Councils, to render their support to our cause
4. The Sierra Leone Police to provide the necessary security for all our elections.
